**Rich Wasser  
Gold Life Master**

Rich Wasser is a Renaissance man—in his job history, in his hobbies, and in his fitness. With 3,227.4 masterpoints to date, 14th highest in our unit, Rich is a Gold Life Master. He enjoys the challenges of duplicate bridge but stopped playing in tournaments about 15 years

ago.

Terry Tweedt, a college classmate, introduced Rich to bridge at Cal Western University in Point Loma. An all-CIF basketball guard for two years and a League MVP in high school, Rich was offered over 50 scholarships to colleges including UCLA and USC but fell in love with Point Loma when he visited its campus located on a hill overlooking the ocean. He accepted their full-ride scholarship and graduated with a BA in history followed by a masters in Physical Education from LA State University.

Rich's Renaissance of work started with teaching elementary school for four years and then teaching PE for 15 years at Long Beach City College. After that, he opened and operated moped stores in Lakewood and South Bay for four years. For 50 years, he also worked as a licensed real estate broker

and a professional auctioneer for factories, retail, and real estate. Rich was introduced to auctioneering while helping his auctioneer dad since junior high. Although he "retired" in 2014, he still dabbles in both, "I'll be doing a small auction this coming weekend."



Rich was introduced to duplicate early in his bridge career when he and Terry played in a game at the Hotel Del Coronado in 1966. Through the years he played social bridge as well as duplicate at Long Beach Bridge. Rich recalled, "The director didn't play bridge so, after the game

On July 12 Kim Wang and Louis Shen won in a field of nine table, scoring 70.24%



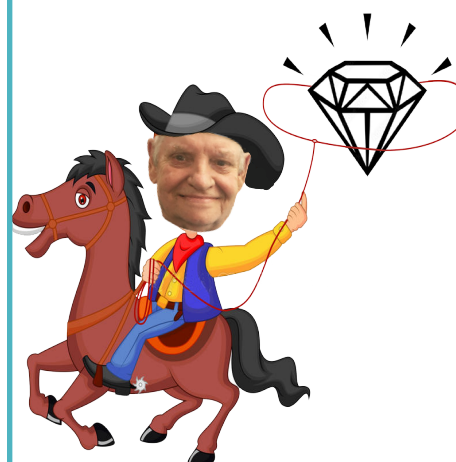
Alan Olschwang and Ken Miller, his brother-in-law from Australia, scored 70.54% in the STaC game on July 23rd in a field of 8 tables.

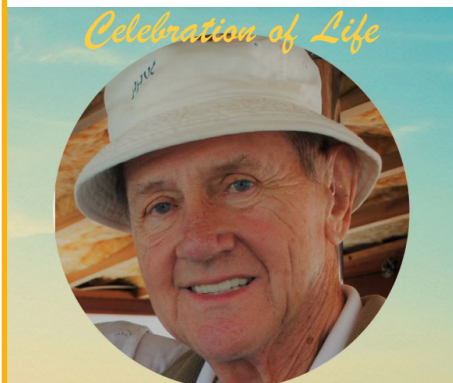

Rich even reconnected with Terry at the club about ten years ago when they both happened to play there at the same time, "It was special to see him after all these years. He was a good friend as well as my first bridge partner."

Rich's long-term partners are Jon Yinger, Earl Van Der Vord, and Mike Welsh. Rich still plays twice a week at the club. His advice to newer players is "Don't worry about having enough time to play. Play when it fits in your schedule. Enjoy the game and you'll continue to play."

As much as Rich enjoys bridge, it is his second favorite hobby with beach volleyball eclipsing it. Introduced to this sport by the man who recruited him to Cal Western, Rich has been playing ever since. Today he plays three times a week at the Belmont Shore volleyball courts. Just last weekend, he and his teammates won the handicapped Dinosaur tournament for the third year in a row. "I'm older than the other players so we get extra points but have always won without them." With his fair complexion, Rich laughingly explained, "I cover up everything when I play but



still end up with a sunburned face." Rounding out his Renaissance of fitness, Rich runs three times a week.

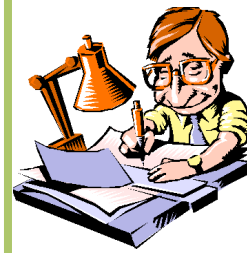
