### Kevin Lane Ruby Life Master

Kevin Lane started playing bridge in 1986 when his dad needed a partner. He had watched his mom and dad play in a monthly social bridge game, so it was somewhat inevitable that Kevin (and his sister) would be recruited. With 2,441.99 masterpoints to date, Kevin is a Ruby Life Master.

Kevin came to Long Beach Bridge in 1992 when his dad was visiting from Chicago, and they needed a place to play. And he's been playing here ever since. Today Kevin plays online twice a week with his sister Jan who lives in Chicago and snowbirds in Florida. His regular faceto-face partner is District 23 President Bob Shore.

Kevin became serious about bridge prior to the 2003 Long Beach Nationals. His dad, uncle, and sister needed a fourth for their mini-Spingold 0-1500 team. Although Kevin had a mere 30 masterpoints, he was recruited. Their team made it to the guarterfinals where he played with screens 15 feet away from World Champions Eric Rodwell and Jeff Meckstroth who were playing in the Open Spingold. Kevin never took bridge lessons but taught himself

by reading over 50 books on the subject. He recommends Eddie Kantor's books on defense as well as those written by Mike Lawrence. Kevin's advice to newer players is "play with fun partners in challenging competitions." His wife Lynn and son Eric don't play bridge, although Eric caddied for several years.

Additionally, Kevin was part of the revitalization of Long Beach Bridge in 2017-2018. He explained, "I am proud to have contributed to revitalizing the club. I think it's a special place that has provided good duplicate bridge games for over 30 years. I'm glad we could keep it going." In fact, Kevin was this writer's first bridge teacher. New students who had played some social bridge were put in Kevin's class to learn Stayman and transfers.

Since 2003, Kevin has actively volunteered his time for bridge for the Long Beach unit and District 23. His volunteerism culminated in being elected as the District 23 representative to the ACBL national board from 2016 to 2021. Kevin added. "I brought (relative) youth to the ACBL board as I advocated for a common sense focus on the critical issues necessary to sustain bridge in the long term."

A special bridge memory was winning the North American Pairs Flight B at the Kansas City Nationals in 2017. His partner was Murat Vesyoglu, an excellent player notable for his positive attitude. They barely made the cut for the second day qualifying 51st out of 52. However, the next day they scored two 65% games and won the event! Kevin noted, "I credit Murat's reflexively positive attitude in securing

that win. I was very fresh the second day because Murat didn't seem to notice or care about my many mistakes—partnership first. It's a lesson that has served me well."

Having graduated from the University of Illinois in computer science, Kevin spent most of his professional career working for major tech companies like Microsoft and Yahoo. He said, "The pandemic put things sideways, and I'm still figuring out what my life should look like now." Retired from the corporate world in 2010, he is currently "keeping busy with projects around the house."

The next time Kevin comes to your table, remember his advice to challenge yourself and "have fun" since you will be definitely be playing a competitive round.

Face-to-face clubs can hold Junior Fund Games, which raise money for this initiative, throughout the month of January. These games will also give out upgraded masterpoint awards.


