Hank Dunbar has the enthusiasm and patience to take his Bridge 1 class of 28 students from using bidding boxes to bidding and playing basic hands. He has recently revamped the sequence of his classes to introduce Play of the Hand earlier and to spread the bidding sequences over a longer period of time in order to not overwhelm students. The current Bridge 1 class includes 12 students recruited from ACBL's BOOST program, a list generated by ACBL and provided to qualified teachers. Hank personally contacted all of these referrals to enroll the 12 in this session. July's Bridge 2 class had 20 students, and the current Bridge 3 has 12 students. Hank added, "We end each session with tournaments involving Bridge 1 students and other players with under 20 masterpoints. Some pairs are even venturing into the NLM games" Several students joined ACBL, and Hank received a personal thank you from Bronia Jenkins, Executive Director of ACBL.

Rob Preece developed a Monday morning class that introduces and reviews topics for evolving and intermediate students. With his characteristic wit and duck whistle, he covers topics from Jacoby 2NT to Modern Drury. Rob continues to de-



continued from page 2 velop curriculum, attracting 11-12 tables for each lesson. Fern Dunbar assists Rob in this class. Additionally, Rob is always available to answer questions and to review hands after any game in which he plays.

Dalia Hernandez is the queen of conventions, teaching an online class every Monday evenings for advancing players. At the same time, she continues to mentor new and prior students and is always willing to answer in-person or emailed questions on bidding or play of the hand.

Students can practice their skills and and log "time at the table" during the Tuesday and Wednesday morning 199'er games. Rob directs and supervises the Tuesday game with Fern's help. Sharon Biederman conducted the Wednesday game and is now passing the baton to Leo Dittemore. Players, when they feel comfortable, can graduate to NLM and then Open games.

Long Beach Bridge is fortunate to offer this structured sequence of classes and games to support its players. And, it is only possible thanks to our teachers who volunteer their time and energy to inspire and coach others. Thank you!
