We were fortunate to receive several generous donations this past year, including a notable gift made in memory of Jerry Glenn, for which we are very thankful.


Another well-deserved mention: **Congratulations to Cherene Birkholz** on advancing her credentials to become a **Sectional-level Director**.

The Friendship Star quilt pattern gets its name from its historical use as a meaningful gift: friends would each make a block, often signing their names in the center, and present them to someone embarking on a long journey (like westward expansion), creating a comforting memory quilt symbolizing their bond. This tradition dates back to pioneer days, with the star representing guidance, support, and love, making it popular for charity quilts, block swaps, and memory quilts today.

Perhaps Nancy's quilt can also symbolize the many friendships will have made on our long bridge journeys.
